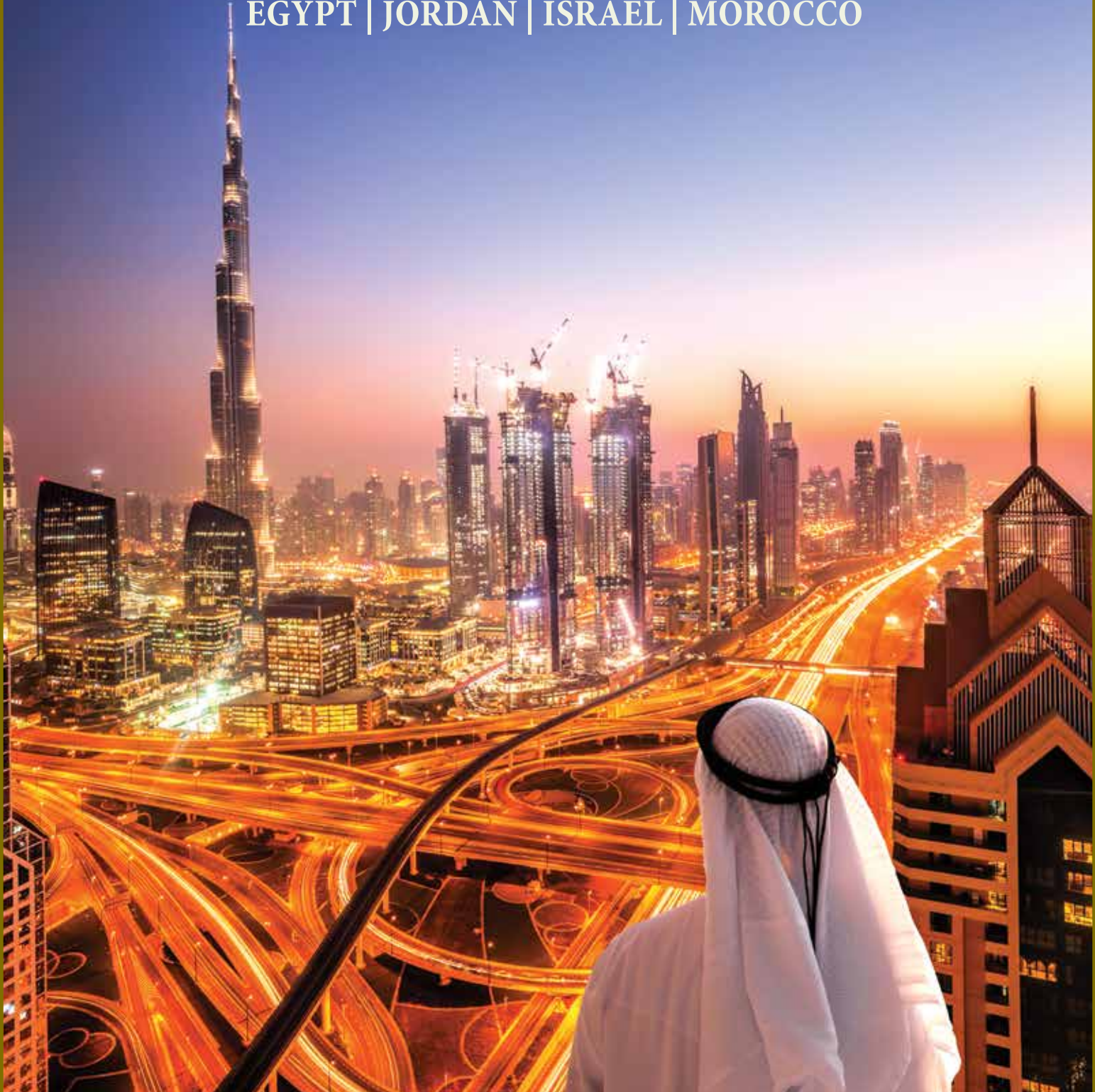

Dubai

Dubai is the second largest of the seven Emirates and it is famous for building the first, largest, unique and the biggest constructions in the world. It constantly dwells in a suppressive competition with itself trying to magnetize tourists to a dreamy world of attractions and unheard-of luxuries. Spend time wandering through the souks and along the waterfront to take in the city's atmosphere. There is almost nothing 'old' in Dubai, but it is the one place in the Gulf where that hardly seems to matter.

Dubai is surrounded by a vast desert and the stunning Hajar Mountains; the city is divided by the Creek splitting the commercial centre into two parts - Deira and Bur Dubai. In the city, you'll find incredibly high tech buildings close to old traditional houses and mosques, amazing beach resorts are just a short drive from the city centre.

Abu Dhabi

Captivating culture, breath-taking luxury, exhilarating adventure and the warmth of Arabian hospitality await you in Abu Dhabi. Feel awed by one of the world's top landmarks - the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque - take on the planet's fastest roller coaster at Ferrari World Abu Dhabi, zoom to the pace of a speedboat tour of the UAE capital's coastline, indulge in sandboarding in Al Dhafra, and enjoy the peace and tranquillity of a stroll through Al Ain's cooling oasis. Sharjah

Many of the early settlements were based around the 'falaj', a man-made underground watercourse. Sharjah is renowned throughout the Arab world for its commitment to art, culture and preserving the local heritage, this emirate is the place to visit to explore, experience and discover the secrets of a unique Arabian lifestyle and Islamic culture. Sharjah offers an impressive array of over twenty museums several art galleries and beautifully restored heritage areas.

Al Ain

Not too far from Dubai or Abu Dhabi is Al Ain, one of the world's oldest permanently inhabited settlements, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city abounds in picturesque forts. One of the UAE's most historic buildings, Al Jahili Fort was erected in 1891 to defend the city. You can visit the Al Ain National Museum which lets you explore various aspects of UAE life, including Bedouin jewellery and traditional musical instrument collections. For stunning views of the city, visit the top of Jebel Hafeet - a rocky height dominating the city - via a winding highway. Other attractions include the Al Ain oasis with its cool, shady walkways and a 3,000year-old falaj irrigation system, and the camel market - one of the last few remaining.

JORDAN

Jordan is a land of ancient heritage that until relatively modern times has lived in the fold of great empires, most often existing as an important trading and communications link. Jordan's millennia of human settlement have left it with varied archaeological treasures that range from Neolithic villages and four thousand years old frescoes to the Greco-Roman splendour of Jerash, the mosaic riches of Byzantine Madaba and the rock-carved wonders of Nabataean Petra.

Since time immemorial, the lands of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan have witnessed many civilizations emerge, conquer, thrive and then vanish. Wave after wave of Nabateans, Ammonites, Edomites, Canaanites, Greeks and Romans left its mark on the desert, hills and plains of Jordan.



Amman

The modern Jordanian capital city of Amman is only the latest in a long series of communities that have flourished on the same spot for thousands of years. Among Amman's most noteworthy places to visit are the archaeological museum on citadel hill, the Jordan museum of popular traditions and the Jordan folklore museum flanking the Roman theatre, the Jordan craft centre and the Jordan national gallery.

Petra

Petra is magnificent, mysterious and always thrilling, two thousand years ago, the Nabataean carved a city out of the Rose-Red Rock and built an empire based on advanced agricultural techniques and control of area's strategic trade routes. Petra was protected for several hundred years by a ring of impenetrable mountains, breached only by the kilometre-long fissure through the mountains known as the Siq.

Dead Sea

The Dead Sea is known in Hebrew as Yam Ha-Melakh (the Sea of Salt) is the lowest point on earth, surrounded by the stunning landscape of the Negev Desert. The shores of the Dead Sea are the lowest point on the surface of the earth, and the saline water of the lake give a lead to the name 'Dead Sea' because no fish can survive in the salty waters. The other result of the salty water of the Dead Sea is their renowned health and healing properties and the unique feature that one can float naturally in them.

Marrakech

A former imperial city in western Morocco is a major economic centre and home to mosques, palaces and gardens. The medina is a densely packed, walled medieval city dating to the Berber Empire with mazelike alleys where thriving souks (marketplaces) sell traditional textiles, pottery and jewellery. Built in the eleventh century, the Jemaa el Fna has become a symbol of Marrakech and enjoys protection since 1922, under the artistic heritage of Morocco. It offers a unique concentration of traditions, such as the tales of storytellers, traditional medicine and various forms of entertainment as well as commercial.

Casablanca

Casablanca is Morocco's largest city with a population of almost 4 million and also boasts the world's largest artificial port but no ferry service of any kind. Casablanca is also the most liberal and progressive of Morocco's cities. It is a commercial hub in western Morocco, fronting the Atlantic Ocean. The city's French colonial legacy is seen in its downtown Mauresque architecture, a blend of Moorish style and European art deco. Standing partly over the water, the enormous Hassan II Mosque, built in 1993, has a 210m minaret topped with lasers directed toward Mecca.

Fes

Fes is the second-largest city of Morocco, with a population of 1.1 million. It is a northeastern Moroccan city often referred to as the country's cultural capital. It's primarily known for its Fes El Bali walled medina, with medieval architecture, vibrant souks and old-world atmosphere. The medina is home to religious schools such as the 14th-century Bou Inania and Al Attarine, both featuring elaborate cedar carvings and ornate tile work.
